The spaces within, beyond and between Michelangelo Buonarotti and Michelangelo the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtle are teeming with dangers as well as possibilities. Some of the dangers: turning into kitsch, becoming irrelevant, or obscure. Some possibilities: relevance, clarity. The exhibition **Dime a Dozen** looks into the negotiation of these places full of dangers and possibilities by artists using other artworks and technology. This exhibition attempts to map the journey of cultural objects across social strata and across trendy crosscurrents/channels. Works of 19th century Filipino masters Juan Luna and Felix Resurreccion Hildago and contemporary Filipino artists Tad Ermitano, Alwin Reamillo and Gerardo Tan are some of the pieces featured. The exhibition opens on June 8 and will end on September 22, 2007.
